





NOTE: JUNCTION BOXES MUST BE SOLIDLY FIXED TO THE CEILING AND ATTACHED TO THE STRUCTURAL MEMBER INSIDE THE CEILING BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH INSTALLATION.

Screw on the male cable gripper to the middle support bracket.

Secure power cord to aircraft cable using plastic cable ties.


Tighten the screws to connect the two middle brackets together.



Fixture must be hung level at the desired height. If fixture is not level, light leaks may occur at the seam.

GENERAL INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS - See submittal drawings for job specific data.

- Installation by a certified electrician only.
- Read and understand the installation instructions before attempting to install or use the fixture.
- Only use fixtures with voltage for which it is rated. Do not exceed the specified voltage and current input.
- Do not use the fixture if the housing, lens, or power cable is damaged.
- Ensure that the main power supply is off before installing or wiring the fixture.
- Method of wire connection to be determined by local electrical codes and regulations.
- The external flexible cable of this luminaire cannot be field replaced; if the cord is damaged, contact Coronet.
- The light source contained in this luminaire shall only be replaced by the lighting manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person.
